The Massachusetts Law School Consortium would like to invite you to participate in our **2010 National Recruitment Program** which is designed to make your visit to Massachusetts more productive and efficient. Since 1985, the Consortium has worked cooperatively to enable visiting employers to interview well-qualified students from all of the ABA accredited Massachusetts-area law schools.

If you are already scheduled to interview at Harvard Law School, you may schedule interviews for Consortium students the day before, the day after, or the morning of your scheduled visit to Harvard (Harvard Law School interviews begin at 1:00pm.). If you are not interviewing at Harvard, we can coordinate an interview date for you at your convenience. The interviews can take place at Suffolk University Law School or at an area hotel.

If you choose to participate in the National Recruitment Program, resumes from the seven law schools will be forwarded to you at least two weeks in advance of your scheduled interview date. You may then pre-select the students you wish to interview during your trip to Massachusetts. (Scheduling on-campus interviews with Harvard Law School students, if applicable, will be handled separately in accordance with Harvard's interview procedures and with Harvard's staff.) Scheduling for the National Recruitment Program will be handled by Michelle Dobbins, Associate Director, at Suffolk University Law School.

Interviews will begin on September 7, 2010 and run through October 29, 2010. If you wish to participate, please fill out the attached Registration Form and return it to Suffolk Law School as soon as possible along with your \$100 registration fee and eight copies of your organization's descriptive materials.
